The jurors for the State upon their oath present that on or about the date of offense shown and in the county named above the defendant named above unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously did knowingly distribute and give away and otherwise cause to be placed in a position of human accessibility and ingestion, food and beverage and an eatable or drinkable substance that the defendant knew to contain a poisonous chemical and compound and a foreign substance, trazodone, which might which might cause death, serious physical injury or serious physical pain and discomfort to minor female K.C., dob 01/15/2009.

II. And jurors for the State upon their oath present that on or about the date of offense shown and in the county named above the defendant named above unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously did knowingly distribute and give away and otherwise cause to be placed in a position of human accessibility and ingestion, food and beverage and an eatable or drinkable substance that the defendant knew to a poisonous chemical and compound and a foreign substance, trazodone, which might which might cause death, serious physical injury or serious physical pain and discomfort to minor female N.P., dob 06/01/2010.

III. And the jurors for the State upon their oath present that on or about the date of offense shown and in the county named above the defendant named above unlawfully, willfully, and feloniously did attempt to inflict serious physical injury upon minor female N.P., dob 06/01/2010, who was 15 years old and thus under 16 years of age. At the time the defendant inflicted the injury the defendant was providing care and supervision to the minor.
