THIS CAUSE was heard by the undersigned judge on Plaintiff’s motion for partial summary judgment under Rules 56(a) and (c) of the Rules of Civil Procedure against Defendants The Chemours Company, The Chemours Company FC LLC, and E.I. DuPont de Nemours and Company as to their liability on Count IV (Public Nuisance) and Count II (Trespass). It appears to the Court that there is no genuine issue as to any material fact and that the Plaintiff is entitled to a partial judgment as a matter of law on the issue of liability.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that partial summary judgment is hereby GRANTED in favor of Plaintiff against Defendants The Chemours Company, The Chemours Company FC LLC, and EIDP, Inc. (f/k/a E.I. DuPont de Nemours and Company) on the issue of liability on Count IV (Public Nuisance) and Count II (Trespass) and that this action shall be tried by a jury on the issue of damages and abatement remedies only for those claims.
